Plattsburgh International Airport Announces New Bus Service to Airport Bus Lines Now Connect Quebecers to “Montreal’s U.S. Airport”

Plattsburgh, NY – 6/30/08 – Plattsburgh International Airport today announced new bus service connecting Quebecers to “Montreal’s U.S. Airport.”

Working jointly, Adirondack Trailways and Greyhound bus lines will provide service to the airport’s passenger terminal as part of their Montreal - New York City route. The new service, effective immediately, will help make Plattsburgh International Airport an even more affordable and convenient choice for Quebecers. Fares are just \$20 (U.S.) one-way and \$40 (U.S.) roundtrip.

The new service will leave Montreal at 7:00 am and 2:05 pm. The bus route also includes service from Longueuil at 2:20 pm. The service from the Plattsburgh International Airport is at 12:00 pm and at 8:00 pm arriving in Montreal 2 hours later and in Longueuil at 9:50 pm.

“Clinton County is pleased with the decision by Adirondack Trailways and Greyhound to provide regular service between Montreal and Plattsburgh International Airport. The Montreal region provides a strong customer base for our airport, and the newly announced bus service will provide a good alternative to those passengers that desire to leave their cars at home, especially given the current climate of high gas prices. We believe this service will be well received by the users of the airport and will enhance the convenience of passenger flights at Plattsburgh International Airport,” stated Rodney Brown, Clinton County Planning Director.

Garry Douglas, President & CEO, Plattsburgh-North-Country Chamber of Commerce, added, "Regular bus service is the next logical step in building the connection between Montreal and Plattsburgh International Airport. We already know that many of our Quebec passengers are being dropped off at the airport. This bus connection will provide a convenient option for all of our passengers, including those who don't have cars. Our growing status as Montreal's U.S. Airport is further strengthened with this announcement."
